Please send your abstract to sala.conference.37@gmail.com no later than **March 31, 2023**. All abstracts should adhere to the following guidelines:

- **Anonymity:** abstracts should be anonymous and any identifying information (i.e. names of the presenters, their affiliations or addresses) must be removed;
- **Length:** 1 page excluding examples, tables and references;
- **Format:** abstracts should be submitted in PDF format;
- **Preferred session:** authors should indicate in their abstract whether they wish to present their paper in the *general session* or in the co-organized workshop *Complex verb constructions in Indo-Aryan and beyond*, convenors Eystein Dahl (UiT - The Arctic University of Norway) and Beatrice Grieco (Università per stranieri di Siena); description at the link <https://sala37.wixsite.com/sala-37-venice/ws-complex-verb-constructions>).

Notification of acceptance/rejection will be given by May 10, 2023.
